

## **WHPE Outstanding Health/Physical Education Coordinator/Supervisor Award**

This award is presented to an individual who while serving as a coordinator/supervisor K-12 (Health and/or Physical Education) has dedicated him/herself to excellence and promoted the Mission of WHPE.

This individual must exemplify the highest standards with regard to:

- a) Advocacy for health and / or physical education,
- b) Contributions made to the development/implementation of standards based PE/health curriculum,
- c) Innovative methodology for b.,
- d) Leadership/service to WHPE,
- e) Professional participation through inservices, workshops; convention presentations,
- f) Scholarship as demonstrated via publication, research or grant acquisition and
- g) Demonstrated communication skills with staff, administrators; the public at large.

The recipient must have a minimum of 5 yrs WHPE membership and have served in his/her coordinator/supervisor role for a minimum of 5 yrs. Only one such award will be given each year.

Individuals who are nominated for this award must submit the WHPE cover letter, two (2) letters of support that specifically address the criteria a. – g. and a personal vita (not to exceed 10 pages).
