	WHPE & related prof. Committees: Multiple committees served on = 5, 2-3 committees served on = 3; service on at least 1 committee = 1
	Long history with WHPE: 20+ yrs. = 5, 18– 20 yrs. = 3; 15– 17 yrs. = 1
	Excellence in Teaching: Nat'l. TOY/NBCT = 5, District TOY = 4, State TOY = 3; local teaching excellence = 1
	Research/or Presentations- Evidence of either or both: 5 = Nat'l. level, 4 = District, 3 = State; 1 = local ** score & add totals for all that apply!
	Publications: Nat'l. publication = 5, District publication = 4, WI/WHPE or other publication = 3; locally published = 1 ** score & add totals for all that apply!
