HEALTH EDUCATOR TEACHER OF THE YEAR

WHPE membership is required with at least five years of membership and five years of teaching experience in the field of Health Education. Additional criteria include: significant contributions to the profession in the areas of teaching, research, creative activities, and service. SHAPE membership is required if the State winner wishes to have his/her application advanced to the Midwest District selection process. Three letters of reference are required, as are answers to specific questions to accompany nomination.
